



Rider Race Pack for Rounds One & Two

Round One - 10.12.16 - Jubberland

Round 2 – 11.12.16 - Bendigo

Race Format/Categories:

The race will be a classic XCO format with laps around an approximately 5km loop. The number of laps to be completed will be dependent on the category entered. At each round there will be 2 race start times. The groups for these start times have been created to group riders who through MTBA recommendations are to compete for similar time lengths. This also means that as a general rule faster riders are not sharing the course with more beginner slower riders which makes it more enjoyable for everybody.

Start Group 1 – 9:00am start time

1A – Under 17 Men, Ultra Masters Men

1B – Open Women, Veteran Women, Masters Women, Super Masters Women, Under 19 Women Under 17 Women

1C – Under 15s Men / Women, Under 13 Men / Women

No new laps are allowed to be started by any categories in these groups after 1:30 of race time. Any riders not allowed to go out will record a finish as +1 Lap or similar as their position in the race when they crossed the line the last time.

Start Group 2 – 10:45 Start Time

2A – Elite Men, Veteran Men, Under 19 Men

2B – Open Men, Elite Women

2C – Masters Men, Super Masters Men

No new laps are allowed to be started after the first elite rider has crossed the line to complete their race. Any riders not allowed to go out will record a finish as +1 Lap or similar as their position in the race when they crossed the line the last time.

Open Men & Women (1.40 – 1.55)

Veteran Men & Women (1.15 – 1.30)

Masters Men & Women (1.00 – 1.15)

Super Master Men & Women (0.45 – 1.00)

Ultra Master Men & Women (0.45 – 1.00)

U19 Men & Women (1.00 – 1.15)

U17 Men & Women (0.45 – 1.00)

U15 Men & Women (0.30 – 0.45)

U13 Men & Women (0.30 – 0.45)

Registration:

All riders must attend the registration area to collect their race number prior to the event. Unless a day license has been purchased all riders must show their MTBA license to collect their race number.

Registration will open at each event site from 7:30am on the day of the round and will close 30 minutes prior to your categories race start (see above for race start times)

Race Briefing:

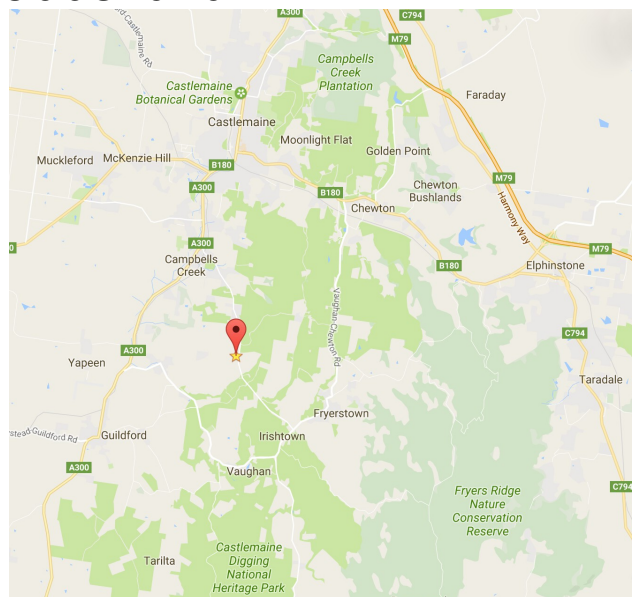
At 8:45 all riders from Start Group 1, and at 10:30 all riders from Start group 2 will be asked to gather in the starting area, where they will be addressed and be given the race briefing which will explain procedures of the race.

Course Practice and Inspection

Course practice and inspection will be available on the evening prior to each round with camping available at the course. And also on the morning of the event before 8:30am when the course will close in preparation for race time.

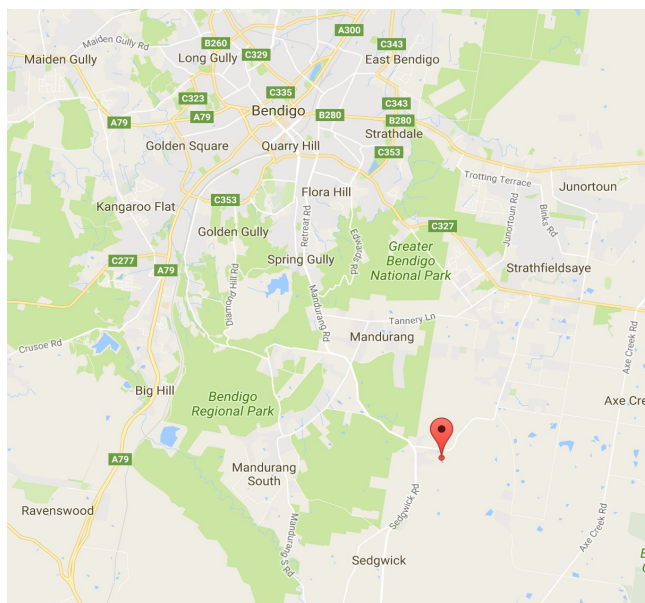
Round One – Jubberland

Event Parking

Parking will be available on site. Please respect any directions given so that we can keep the course safe for riders.

Medical Aid

The event will be manned by first aid personnel. We ask that the first person who comes across an injured rider stops to help, and the second person notifies the next race marshal who will contact the paramedics. We recommend all riders are members of the Ambulance Service as in the event an emergency the paramedics will call for an ambulance.

Facilities, food and drinks

As this is a rural area minimal Potable Water will be available onsite so please make sure you bring your own.

Portable toilets will be available at the event site.

A coffee machine will be providing the required elixir of life for \$3 each (bringing change/smaller notes would be appreciated)

Camping

Camping will be available at both race venues for the night prior to the event. A donation of \$5 per camper would be appreciated. Toilet facilities will be available but all other amenities are to be provided by the riders (and their entourage).
